Sheep – Cattle Downs is a protein-mineral supplement for feeding merinos, meat sheep and young cattle grazing in Blacksoil, Buffel, or Mitchell Grass Downs country. This supplement contains a high proportion of quality protein meals and a low percentage of salt to ensure acceptance in good quality country and where saline herbage is growing.
